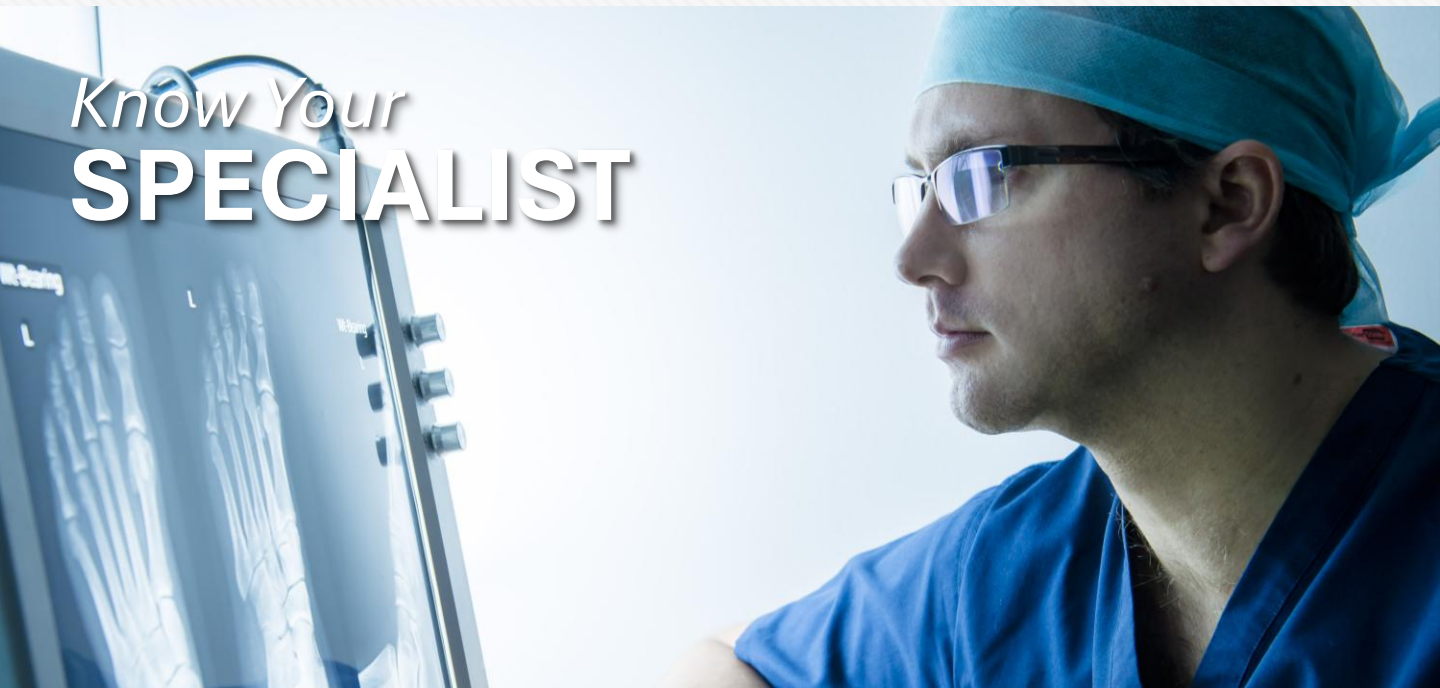

About

MR SIMON E SMITH is a surgical podiatrist and performs reconstructive foot surgery.

Mr Smith obtained his undergraduate podiatry degree from La Trobe University in 1997 and completed his Master of Podiatry from Curtin University in 2004. Simon undertook his specialist training in podiatric surgery (foot and ankle reconstructive surgery) with the Australasian College of Podiatric Surgeons in 2003 and was awarded Fellowship with the College in 2009. Simon expanded his surgical experience overseas with preceptorships in the NHS in the United Kingdom and in the United States. During this time, Simon trained in premier residency programs with leaders in the field of foot surgery. His undergraduate and Master degrees, together with his surgical Fellowship, culminates in 13 years of education and training specific to the foot and ankle. Simon is a registered surgical podiatrist and an endorsed prescriber with the Podiatry Board of Australia.

Simon was awarded the Australian Post Graduate Award Scholarship in 2009 for undertaking research in hallux valgus (bunion) pathology. Simon has published scientific and surgical technique papers in international foot and ankle surgery journals and has frequently presented to his peers at state and national conferences. Simon is dedicated to peer education and has frequently presented at state and national conferences and seminars. He is a teaching Fellow with the Australasian College of Podiatric Surgeons and past lecturer in undergraduate surgical podiatry and anaesthesia at LaTrobe University.

PRACTICE AND SURGERY FOCUS

The focus of Simon Smith's surgical practice is the management of forefoot disorders. Common conditions treated by Mr Smith include bunion and lesser toe deformity correction, big toe joint arthritis, management of bursitis and neuroma and the surgical management of ingrown toenail and painful corns.

Simon Smith is a **Fellow of the Australasian College of Podiatric Surgeons (ACPS)**. Fellows of the ACPS are podiatrists who have completed extensive, post-graduate medical and surgical training, which enables them to perform reconstructive foot surgery. The qualifications of Fellows of the ACPS are recognised by Australian State and Federal Governments. Fellows of the ACPS are included within both the Health Insurance Act and the National Health Act. Surgical podiatrists are registered specialist surgeons under the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency.
